We also participated in the historic Million Women March in Washington D.C. with an hour-long feature on stage, dedicated to prayer for Israel, the return of hostages taken by Hamas more than a year ago, and a specific focus on breaking the spirit of anti-Semitism.

And thanks to you, we were able to launch the *Flags of Fellowship* campaign. We partnered with churches, synagogues, universities, and Christian leaders in a powerful display of solidarity across every state in America. These supporters planted 1,200 Israeli flags on their church grounds – one for every innocent life taken on October 7.

Through these efforts the world knows that Christians and Jews, bound together by shared values, are standing together against hatred and anti-Semitism.
